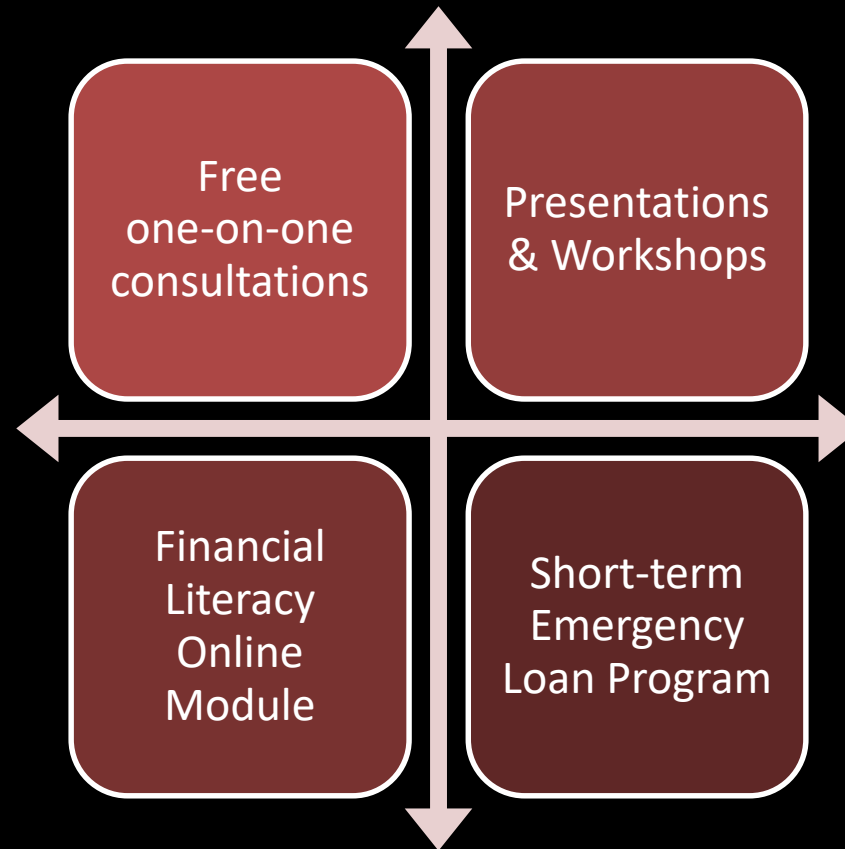

Financial Literacy Program at USC

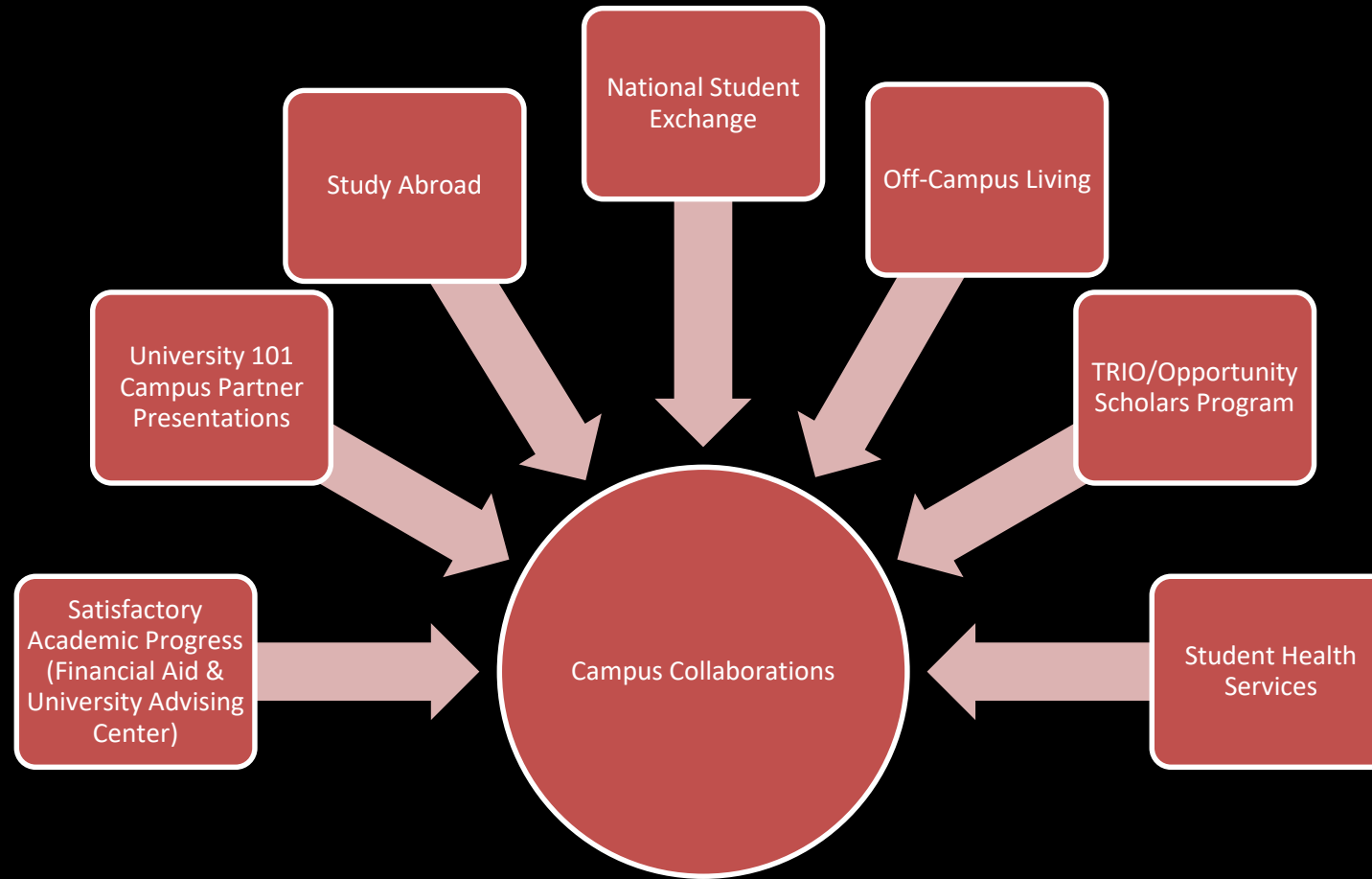
- Founded in 2011

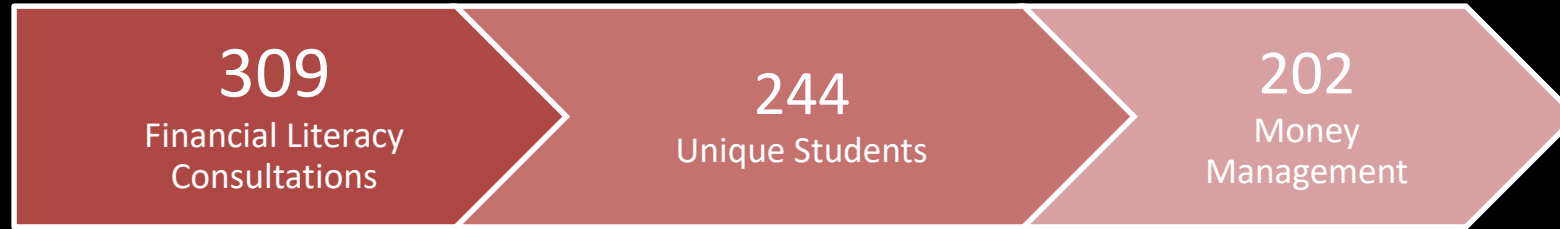
